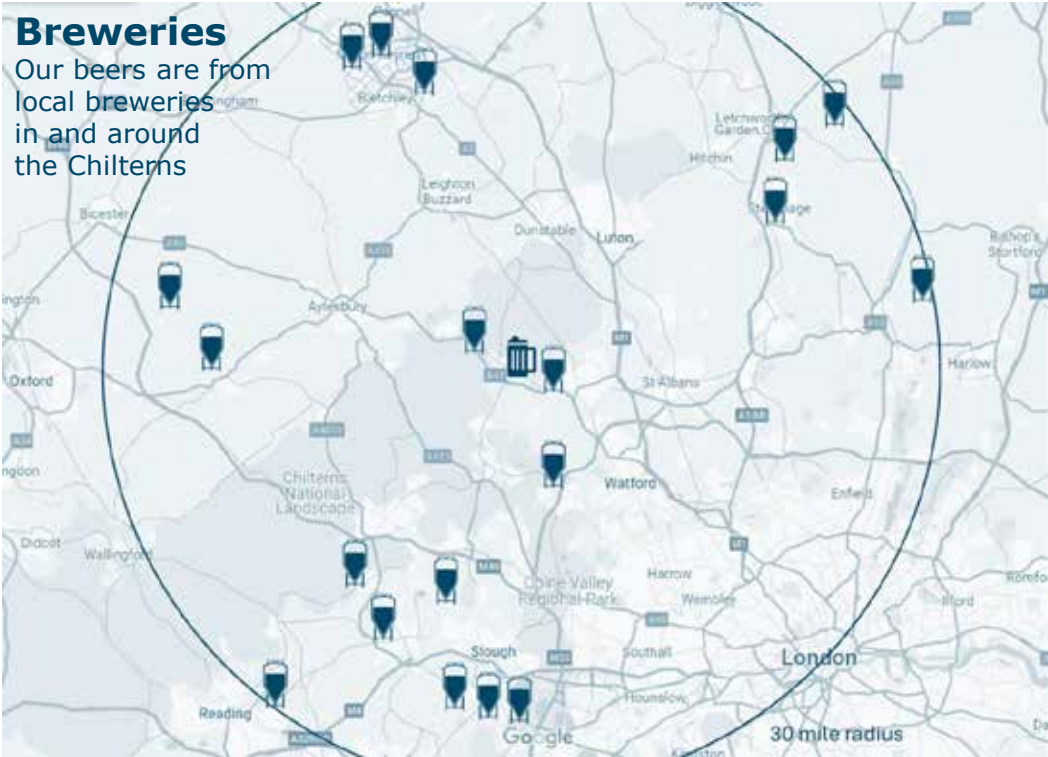

1. 3 Brewers – Blonde 4.2% (15 beer miles)
Light golden in colour, brewed with a big pile of Mosaic hops giving the beer a wonderful hoppy aroma and a refreshing smack of fruity citrusy flavours.



2. 3 Brewers – Golden Ale 3.8% (15 beer miles)
Brewed using Cascade hops giving a subtle citrus flavour, coupled with Cara malt to give a light golden colour and a hint of sweetness.



3. ABC– Thunderclap 4.9% (13 beer miles)
Big citrus flavours hit like the hammer of the gods from a double whammy of Mosaic and Cascade hops. Another classic from this small local brewery.



4. Buntingford – Single Hop Superdelic 4.0% (30 miles)
Superdelic is a triploid hop variety developed in New Zealand, known for its unique flavour profile featuring red fruit, candy, citrus, and tropical fruit notes.



5. Buntingford – Sunstar 4.1% (30 beer miles)
Easy drinking Oatmeal IPA. Brewed using a combination British and American hops, with apricot, lime and papaya high notes and aromas.



6. Chiltern – Earl Grey IPA 3.9% (12 beer miles)
Pale Ale infused with a refreshing citrus burst from the famously bright and fragrant East Africa Earl Grey tea and a balance of Bucks grown barley and English hops.



7. Chiltern – Long Summer Days 4.5% (12 beer miles)
An enticing Extra Pale Ale, with bags of juicy hops and sessionable at 4.5%. Showcasing bold citrus, stone fruit and passion fruit flavours.

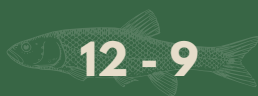

8. Hornes – Tripple Goat Pale Ale 3.9% (23 beer miles)
A refreshingly natural gluten free Pale Ale brewed with malted pale barley, USA Chinook and New Zealand Southern Cross whole flower hops.



9. Hornes – Unlocked Hornes 4.3% (23 beer miles)
A citrusy refreshing gluten free session IPA, packed full of Citra and Simcoe hops. Originally brewed as a 'one off' for the reopening of pubs after the pandemic lockdown.



10. Loddon – Citra Quad 4.4% (29 beer miles)
Heavily hopped with Citra over four stages of the brewing process. The tropical, citrusy aromas are superbly propped up by heaps of oat malts for a smooth hazy session IPA.



11. Loddon – Hocus Pocus 4.6% (29 beer miles)
Brewed using English Goldings and Fuggle hops along with pale and dark malts, and a small amount of invert sugar, which combine to form a rich, smooth traditional dark ale.



12. Loddon – Hoppit 3.4% (29 beer miles)
The predominant hops are East Kent Goldings giving a Seville Orange marmalade flavour. As well as Pale Ale malt, Hoppit contains dark invert sugar giving the beer its smoothness.



13. New River – Blind Poet 4.5% (28 beer miles)
With its four malt varieties providing lightly smoked, liquorice and chocolatey flavours, we imagine our smooth, dark Porter provides the perfect tonic our blind poets mishaps.



14. New River – Twin Spring 4.0% (28 beer miles)
A clear Golden Ale brewed with Caramalt to provide mellow, caramel flavours and New Zealand Waiiti hops to create a gentle fruitiness.

15. Outhouse Brewery – Mochal-Oat 5.4% (30 beer miles)
The brewers have worked their magic with a blend of seven malts to make this stout an irresistible delight, with notes of chocolate and coffee.



16. Outhouse Brewery – Safari Juice 4.5% (30 beer miles)
Head out on Safari with this easy drinking, hazy, tropical IPA. The beer is unfiltered and not pasteurised resulting in a fresh vibrant flavoursome beer.



17. Rebellion – Defender 4.0% (17 beer miles)
A Golden Ale that's single hopped with Callista, which adds distinct fruity and red berry character. A well balanced and refreshing pint.



18. Rebellion – Roasted Nuts 4.3% (17 beer miles)
A deep ruby, complex and flavoursome beer, packed with intense and distinctive malt and hop character. Pale, Crystal, Chocolate malts complement Goldings and Cascade hops.



19. Stardust – Mechanism 4.5% (25 beer miles)
A clean and crisp Pale Ale showcasing English hops. The simple malt base and traditional hot-side hopping create the perfect platform for the Olicana dry-hop.



20. Stardust – Roses 4.5% (25 beer miles)
The second beer from this new Berkshire brewery. This session malty red ale has everything you need: a full body, a wide range of dark malts flavours and a clean finish.



21. Tring – Clawhammer 4.1% (5 beer miles)
A firm thwack of pine and resin make this a true 'West Coast' American Pale. US hops sit flush in a respectable amber body. Grapefruit notes and a rich honey, caramel palate.

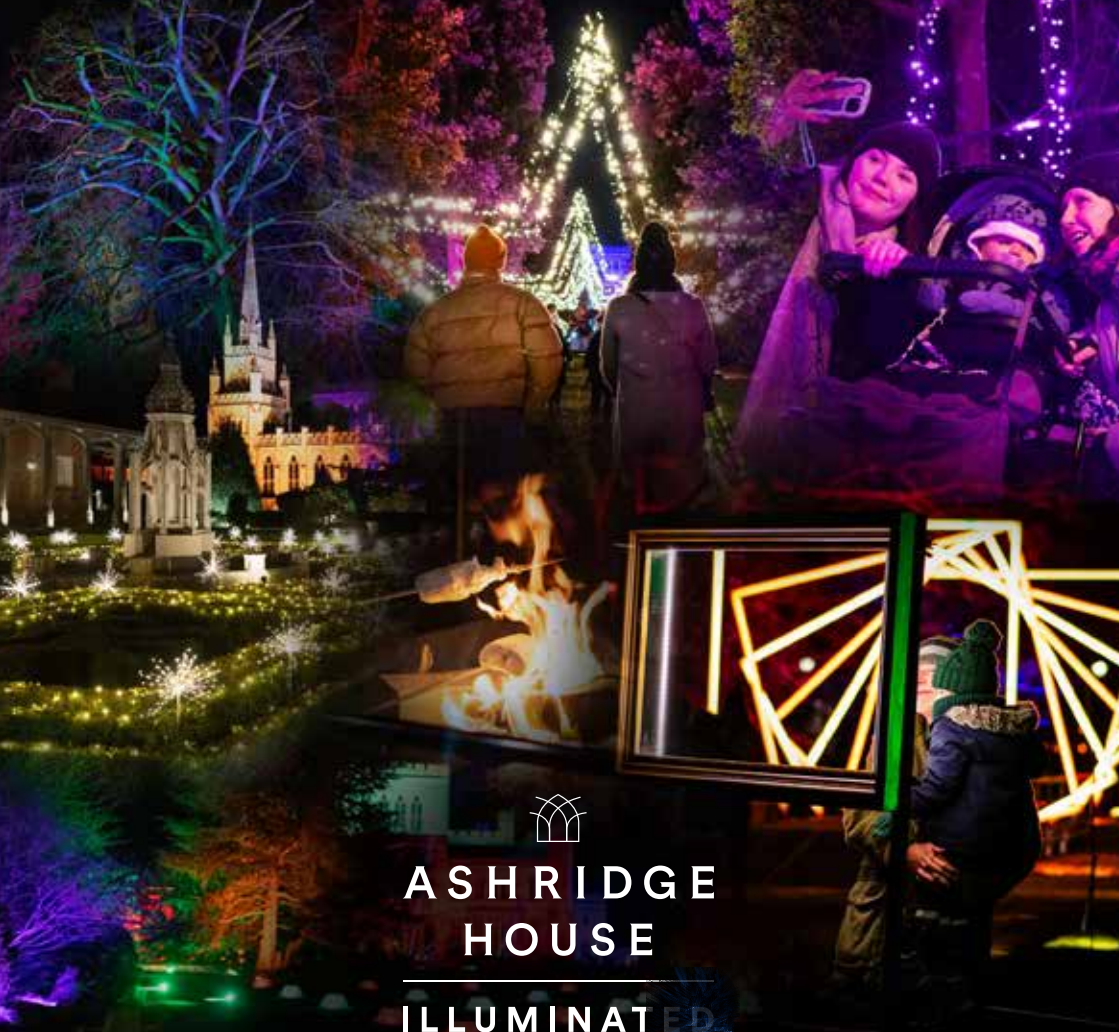

22. Tring – Festival Ale 4.5% (5 beer miles)
A light beer with a golden hue from premium malted barley, which provides pleasant floral aromas of hay and citrus fruits. These aromas open up a palate of grapefruit and pine.




23. Vale – Our Shark 4.1% (28 beer miles)
Celebrate 50 years since the release of Jaws with this summer blockbuster. Bright, fruity hop aromas over a well-balanced malt base.




24. XT – Duttons XB pale Ale 4.4% (21 beer miles)
Brewed by XT under the Dead Brewers Society initiative. They recreate traditional long-lost beer recipes such as this Pale Ale, originally brewed in Blackburn in the 1960s.

Tropical fruits and grassy notes juice it up. Oats and wheat unite for a smoother hazier ride.

 **BrewDog – Punk AF 0.5%**
A postmodern classic, reinvented. Juicy tropical fruit mixes it up with grassy and pine notes for a Pale Ale that's all flavour.

25. Bearwood – Solar Sailer 7.0% (31 beer miles)

Bearwood Brewing strive to make exceptional beers and create memorable moments. This oat cream IPA with a generous base of oats makes for a smooth creamy beer.



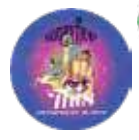
26. Blackened Sun – Space Cadet DDH 5.3% (28 beer miles)

A hazy double dry hopped IPA. This craft ale has a soft mellow malt profile leads to big hop aromas and flavours with notes of tropical fruits.



27. Blackened Sun – Sunspots 4.6% (28 beer miles)

Blackened Sun produces the finest artisan beer. This hazy Pale Ale is light, mellow and easy drinking with notes of citrus, tropical and berry fruits.



28. Booby Trap – This 5.4% (20 beer miles)

A refreshing hazy East Coast IPA, brewed with Cashmere and Azacca hops giving vibrant flavours of creamy citrus and melon, along with a bold tropical tang and pillowy mouthfeel.



29. Booby Trap – Tip of the Iceberg 4.8% (20 beer miles)

Dry hopped with Citra, Simcoe and Centennial, this West Coast Pale Ale has notes of caramel, chewy malt and stone fruit flavours creating a marmalade, piney and resinous beer.



30. Creative Juices – Part Of Me Is You 3.9% (12 beer miles)

A golden coloured Pale Ale with a delicate hop profile with fruity notes of citrus. A single hop variety, Cascade, has been used throughout the brewing process on top quality grain.



31. Creative Juices – The Light Fandango 4.8% (12 miles)

An easy-drinking hoppy pale ale with a slight haze. Offers a fresh tropical note on the nose and a smooth juicy taste, with hints of mango, citrus, pine and herbs.

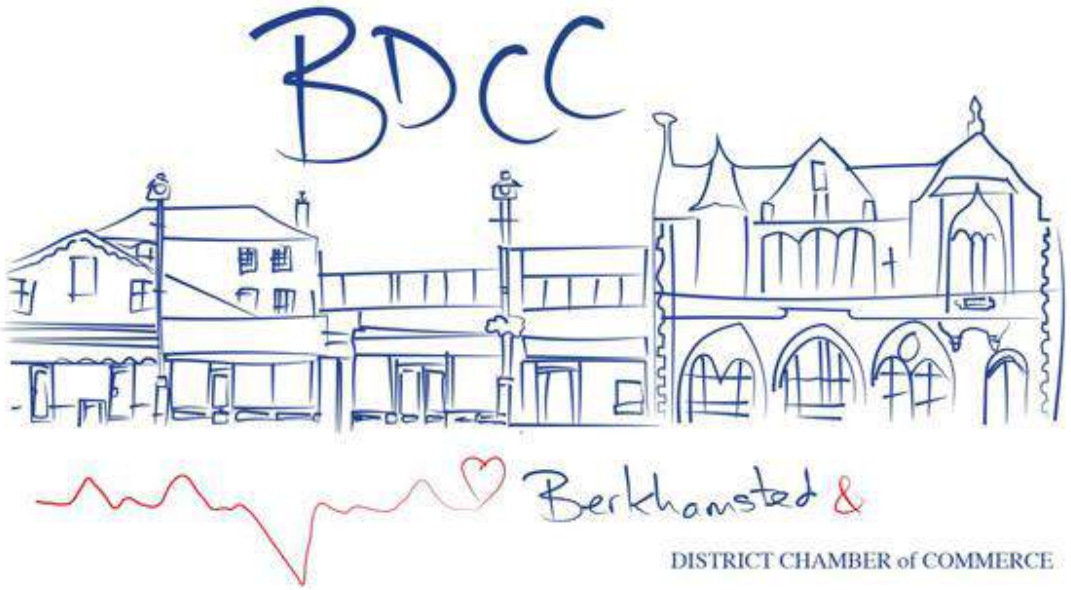

32. Creative Juices – The Slinky Vagabond 5.6% (12 miles)
Brewed with a generous variety of hops, including Cascade, Citra, Simcoe and El Dorado. This IPA has a depth of flavour which you can lose yourself in with a lovely long finish.



33. Crossover Blendery – Persia 6.9% (25 beer miles)
A blend of aged Golden Ale is spontaneously fermented and matured in neutral French oak barrels, then refermented on whole Diamond Bright nectarines grown in Kent.



34. Crossover Blendery – Texas Sunrise 6.7% (25 miles)
A blend of aged Golden Ale is spontaneously fermented and matured in neutral French oak barrels, then refermented on Tayberries and Logan berries grown by a farm in East Sussex.



35. Feisty Beer Co – Bitter & Twisted 6.0% (16 beer miles)
Fresh lemons, limes and lashings of blood orange are added to a West Coast IPA base. This is the perfect summer beer, just be careful of its deceptive ABV!



36. Feisty Beer Co – High Hops 5.5% (16 beer miles)
A bold beer concoction. A hazy CBD infused IPA, with the addition of terpenes from the Super Lemon Haze cannabis strain. Like cloudy lemonade but less sweet.










37. Indie Rabble – Hold Your Horses 6.2% (22 beer miles)
Collaboration with Vibrant Forest. A dry hopped NEIPA with new hop Krush. Expect a stampede of peach, plus orange and lemon citrus top notes saddling a tropical base.



38. Indie Rabble – My Kind of Party 7.0% (22 beer miles)
Raspberry and vanilla biscuit export Stout. This Party Ring biscuit inspired Stout is velvety and sweet, with a biscuit base that breaks like your teenage heart.

39. Indie Rabble – Three of Swords 4.8% (22 beer miles)
Good things come in threes. Raspberry puree, lime zest and Celtic sea salt make up this Margarita inspired sour. Refreshingly sharp and ideal for a summer festival.



40. Rebellion – Hazy Pale 4.3% (17 beer miles)
Hazy, hoppy, fruity and tropical. A fruity and refreshing craft style pale beer, with an emphasis on hop-derived fruitiness and subdued but balanced bitterness.



41. Redchurch – Paradise IPA 3.4% (30 beer miles)
This session IPA is a tropical delight, bursting with flavours of pineapple, mango, and citrus. The combination of fruity hops and a smooth malt backbone creates a harmonious balance.



42. Redchurch – Premium Lager 4.7% (30 beer miles)
German and American hops complement each other and work with the sweetness of the British malt base to provide a refreshing, clean and exceptionally well-balanced beer.



43. Six Hills – John Drives a Superbus 6.5% (23 beer miles)
An IPA deliberately high in alcohol allowing Six Hills to pack in bittering hops without astringency. Each gyle is dry hopped differently to use the best hop combinations available.



44. Six Hills – Running with the Big Dog 4.8% (23 miles)
Single dry hopped NEIPA showcasing Citra. The same wheat, oats and finest barley are used every time as a soft backdrop to further accentuate the hop.



45. Six Hills – Slingshot to Mars 3.8% (23 beer miles)
Slingshot to Mars is a slightly tart raspberry sour, packed with fruit and a touch of salt to finish. Lactic producing yeast gives layers of depth which allows to fruit to sing.

46. Stardust – Saaz Pilsner 4.5% (25 beer miles)
A classic Czech style Pilsner. Using the traditional Saaz hop with a subtle blend of East Kent Goldings, this beer is one flavourful, refreshing Pilsner.



47. Tring – Alchemist 4.5% (5 beer miles)
Lightly-kilned malts are blended with noble hops from the Czechia, Hersbrucker and Saaz, for floral aroma and finished with authentic lager yeast for notes of gentle spice.



48. Tring – Lunardis 4.2% (5 beer miles)
A session hazy Pale Ale with a gentle bitterness from Hersbrucker hops. Simcoe provides aromas of stone-fruit and mango, finished with Comet for a refreshing citrus edge.



49. Tring – Raven King 4.5% (5 beer miles)
This powerful IPA brings waves of tropical fruits from Citra and Mosaic, dry-hopped for extra aroma. Brewed using wheat for a full-bodied, hazy finish.



50. XT – Squid Ink 5.5% (21 beer miles)
Dive into the dark stormy flavours of Squid Ink Black IPA. A bold beast of a beer with its blend of Columbus, Summit, Galaxy and Chinook hops and a tsunami of nine malts.

A medium dry balanced blend of home-grown cider apples creates a moreish sharpness. Although a slightly drier cider, it is still smooth and mellow with a very slight tart finish.



C. Celtic Marches – Thundering Molly 5.2%
A palate pleasing medium cider that is far from mediocre. Meticulously balanced with a golden glow. This scrumptious sip is smooth, well rounded and has a wonderful apple nose.



D. Dorset Nectar – Old Harry Rocks 6.0%
A vintage landmark dry cider. A scrumptious alchemy that celebrates Dorset's Jurassic Coast. 2015 & 2017 British Champion Organic Cider Cup winner.



E. Dorset Nectar – Wild Cat 5.5%
A medium single orchard cider from Bridport with a lingering appley aftertaste. Second place British Champion Organic Cider in 2016.




F. Gwynt Y Ddraig – Two Trees 4.5%
A pale, fruity perry with an aroma of fruit and a hint of honey on the palate. This medium perry was crowned 2015 Champion Perry of Britain.





G. Hecks – Blended Perry 6.0%
Hecks' award-winning Blended Perry is produced like a cider but made from Pears, this has a fragrant odour with plenty of fruit taste and real body.

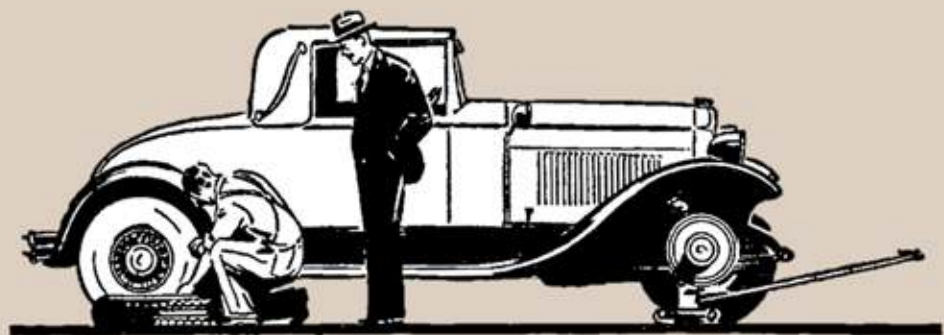

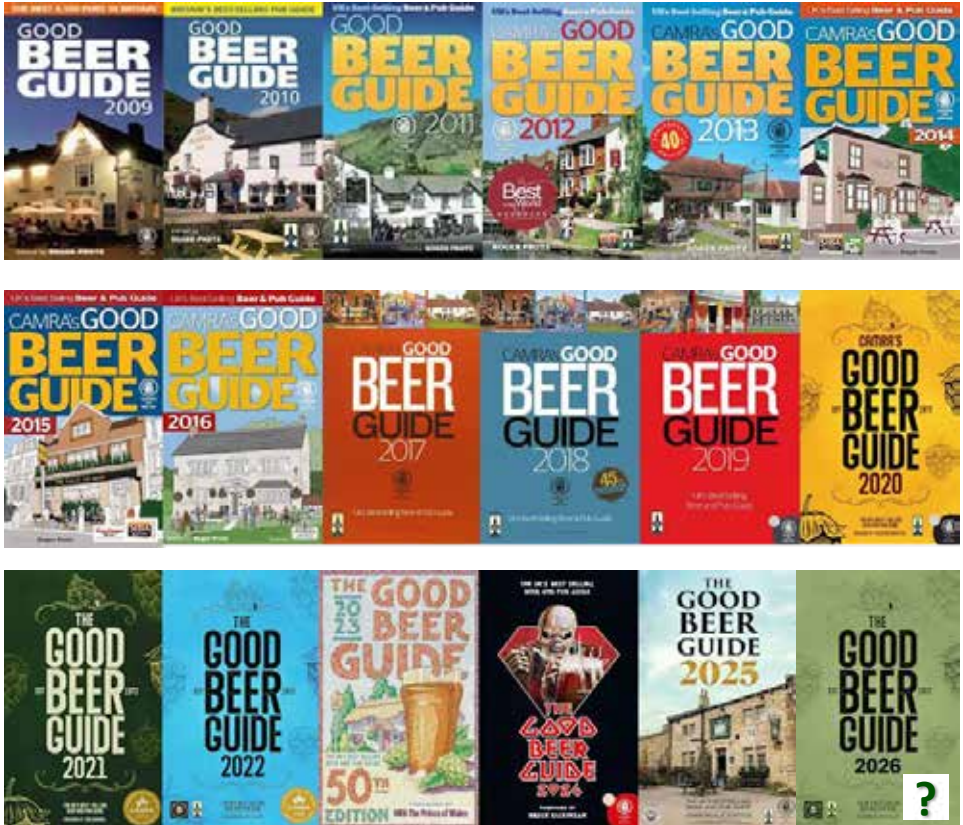
